GRADUATION PRACTICE

- Graduation practice is only for graduating seniors. Parents and guests are not permitted to attend.
- Students must stay for the full day of graduation practice in order to participate in the ceremony.

- Immediately following Cardinal Tribute, seniors will be permitted to leave campus as long as they have a note from a parent/guardian.

BACCALAUREATE

May 25, 2017, 7:00pm

Thomas Nelson High School, Main Gym

- 2017 Graduates from Bardstown High School, Nelson County High School and Thomas Nelson High School will be recognized during our county-wide baccalaureate service.
- Students from each school will walk in a processional with their classmates before the program begins. This is an opportunity for our community to recognize and celebrate all graduating seniors in our area.
- Dress is "Sunday Best." Ladies should wear dresses, skirts, or nice pants and blouses. Gentlemen should wear dress pants and a collared shirt or a shirt and tie. No shorts or flip flops.

GRADUATION

May 26, 2017, 7:30pm

Main Gym

- Doors open for graduation at 6:30pm.
- Admission is by ticket only.
- All seniors must report to the auditorium by 6:30pm on graduation night.

GRADUATION TICKETS

- Tickets will be distributed after graduation practice on May 24th.
- Each senior will receive 10 tickets.

GRADUATION**Dress code:**

- Men should wear dress slacks (navy, khaki, black, etc.) with a light colored, collared shirt and a tie. Dress shoes are required. NO flip flops, work boots or athletic shoes.
- Women should wear a dress or a pair of nice dress pants. Dress shoes are required. All shoes must have a back. NO flip flops, work boots or athletic shoes.

Caps and Gowns:

- All graduating seniors must wear a red cap and gown to graduation.
- Students are not permitted to alter the look of their graduation gown.
- All decorations on your graduation cap must be modest and simple. This will be at the discretion of the administration of Nelson County High School. If you are unsure of whether your decorations will be approved, please see Mrs. Hendricks or Sergeant Pfost for approval **prior to May 20, 2017.**

UNPAID FEES

- Seniors who have any unpaid fees will not be given their graduation tickets. Fees include lunchroom, library, and any school fees turned in to the front office.

FINAL TRANSCRIPT

- Seniors attending college in the Fall MUST send a final transcript via parchment to their college or university.

“DITCH THE DRESS CODE”

- As a final service project, the Class of 2017 is asked to bring in their clean collared shirts. They will be donated to the NCHS Youth Services Center. Students should bring their shirts to graduation practice on May 24th. There will be a collection box in the main gym, where you will report for graduation.

“PAY IT FORWARD”

- If you are not interested in keeping your cap and gown, please drop off your cap and gown in the media center immediately after graduation as you pick up your actual diploma.

CREDITS

- All seniors need 25 credits to graduate. If you are planning on attending summer school, you will not be permitted to walk in the graduation ceremony or participate in graduation practice.
- It is extremely important to be focusing on your grades right now as you finish up your last month at NCHS.
